PRIVACY POLICY FOR ACCESS TO THE SAFEATY SITE

PRIVACY STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF ITALIAN LEGISLATIVE DECREE 196 OF 30/06/2003

1 INTRODUCTION

To whom it may concern When you visit our site, you will not be asked for personal information of any kind except when you fill in forms in order to request information or make suggestions about services that are provided through our site.

In accordance with article 13 of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30/06/2003, "Personal Data Protection Code", and in relation to the personal data to be processed, Safeaty Srl informs you of the following:

2 DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING PURPOSES

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses stated on this site or the completion of forms involves the subsequent collection of the sender's email address required to reply to requests and other personal data that may be included in the message. The information provided will be handled exclusively by the appointed staff.

3 PROCESSING METHOD

The data will be processed using electronic tools in a lawful and proper manner; collected and recorded for the purposes listed above; accurate and up-to-date, relevant, complete and not excessive in relation to the purposes for which they are collected or processed, and kept in a form that allows the identification of the data subject for a period of time not exceeding that necessary for the purposes for which they were collected and processed.

4 MANDATORY NATURE

The data requested by Safeaty Srl must be provided for the requested services to be supplied.

5 CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL TO PROVIDE DATA

Any complete or partial refusal to give consent for the data to be processed will make it impossible to pursue the above purposes. Data subject who fail to enter one or more items of mandatory data will not be able to enjoy the service requested.

6 SUBJECTS TO WHOM THE PERSONAL DATA MAY BE DISCLOSED

The personal data will be processed for the purposes stated above. The data held by Safeaty Srl may be disclosed to private entities (partners, associates, etc.) if such

disclosure is necessary for the performance of the contract or is required by law or regulation, and to any external entities performing specific tasks on behalf of the company. Any sensitive data provided to Safety Srl will not be communicated or disclosed to third parties for any reason and will be processed by us only for the purposes mentioned above.

7 RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

Under article 7 of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, the data subject may access their personal data from the data controller in order to verify the use thereof, or, where necessary, correct it, update it within the limits provided by law, delete it or object to its processing if processed in violation of the law. Any request must be sent to the data controller by registered letter, fax or e-mail.

8 THE DATA SUBJECT HAS THE RIGHT TO OBTAIN

Confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him/her, regardless of whether it is already recorded, and disclosure of such data in intelligible form.

9 FURTHERMORE, THE DATA SUBJECT HAS THE RIGHT TO OBTAIN

- information on the origin of the personal data;
- information on the processing methods and purposes;
- information on the processing methods implemented with the aid of electronic tools;
- information on the identity of the data controller, data processors and their representatives designated pursuant to article 5, paragraph 2;
- updating, rectification or, where appropriate, completion of incomplete data;
- erasure, transformation into anonymous form or denial of access to data processed in violation of the law,
- including those for which there is no need for
- storage in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed;
- certification to the effect that the **updating, rectification or, where appropriate, completion of incomplete personal data, and the erasure, anonymisation or denial of access to data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed**, and the nature of their contents, have been notified to the entities to whom the data were disclosed or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.

10 DATA SUBJECTS HAVE THE RIGHT TO OBJECT, WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY

For legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data concerning them, even if relevant to the purpose of the collection, and to the processing of personal data concerning them for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.

11 DATA CONTROLLER

The data controller is Safeaty Srl. The appointed data processors are the nominated employees of the company. In order to exercise the rights provided for in article 7 of the Italian Privacy Code listed in this document, the data subject must make a request as indicated under Rights of the data subject.

12 PLACE OF STORAGE
